Notice is hereby given that a hearing before the Department of Environmental Management of the State of Alabama will be held on March 19, 2007, at 10:00 am in the Main Hearing Room at the ADEM - Central Office location at 1400 Coliseum Blvd. in Montgomery, for the purpose of revising water quality criteria and establishing standards of quality for surface waters of the State.

The Alabama Department of Environmental Management proposes to amend ADEM Administrative Code Rule 335-6-10-.07 to specify that the aquatic life and human health criteria for mercury shown in Table 1 are expressed as the total recoverable form of the metal in the water column and to clarify that the freshwater aquatic life criteria for selenium shown in Table 1 are expressed as the total recoverable form of the metal in the water column. Also, the Department proposes to amend ADEM Administrative Code Rule 335-6-11-.02 to add the Public Water Supply use classification to a segment of Choccolocco Creek from Boiling Spring Road to Egoniaga Creek in Calhoun County, add the Outstanding Alabama Water use classification to a portion of Wolf Bay from the Intracoastal Waterway to Moccasin Bayou in Baldwin County, and to upgrade a portion of Black Creek in Etowah County from Lake Gadsden to US Highway 431 from the Agricultural and Industrial Water Supply classification to the Fish and Wildlife classification.
