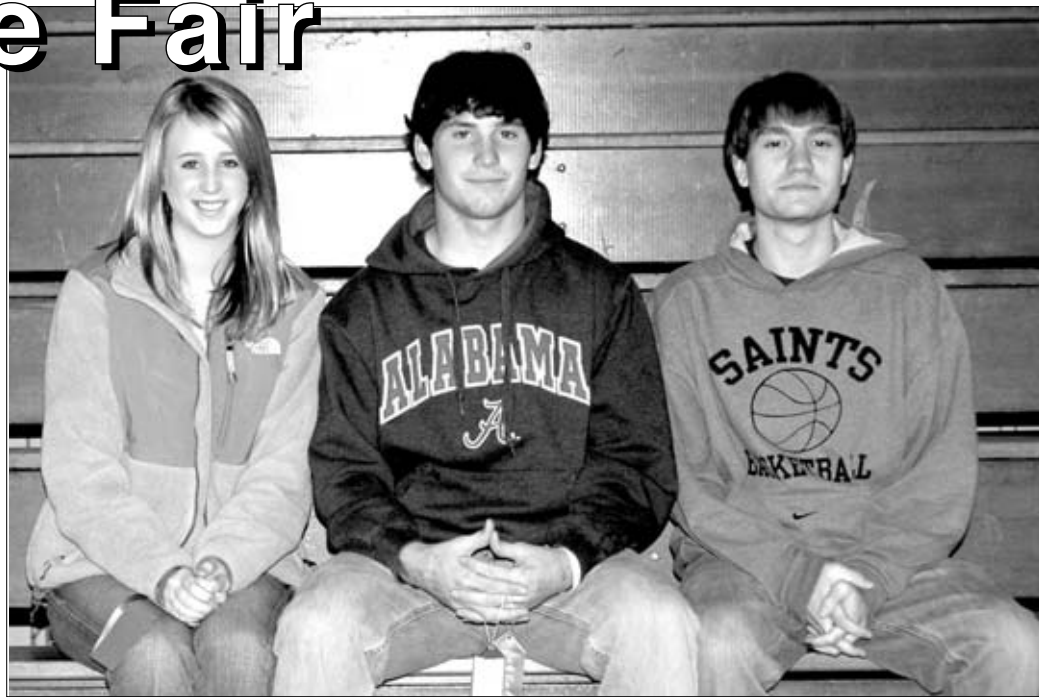
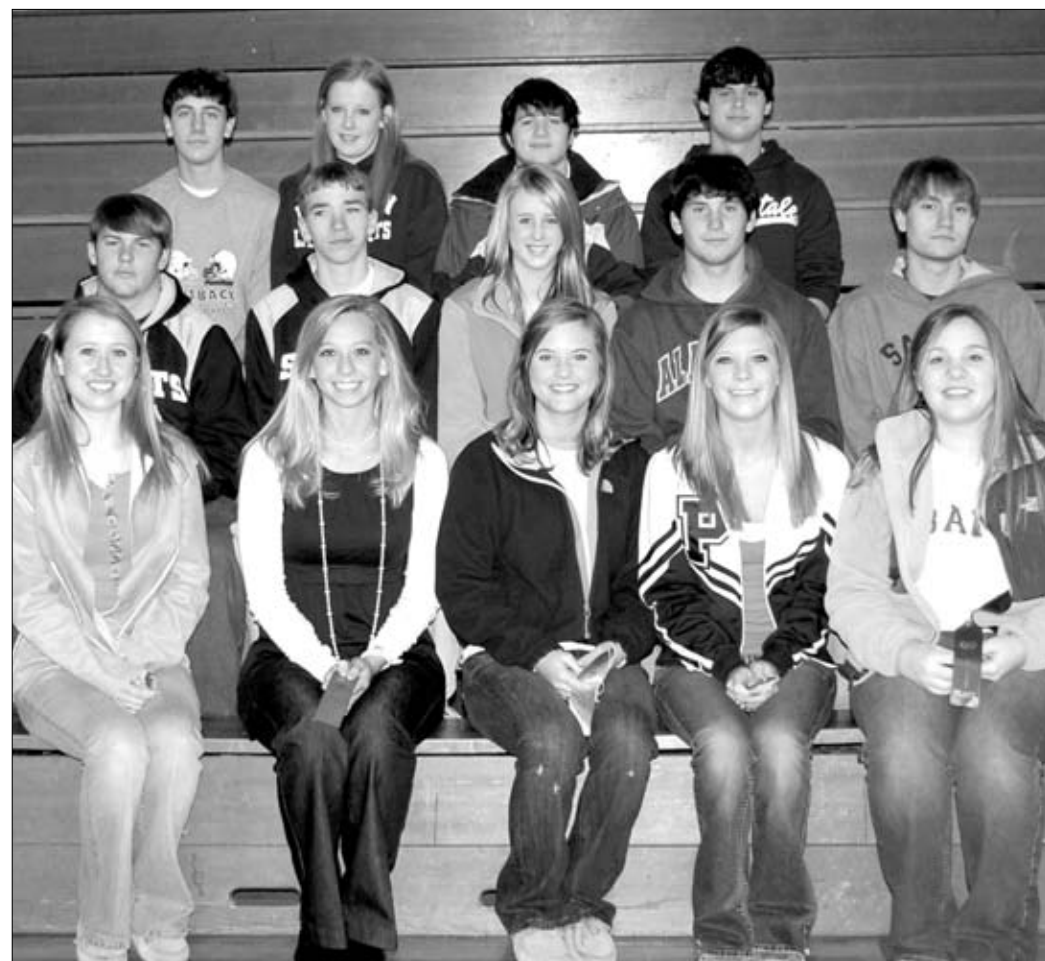


Patrician Science Fair
