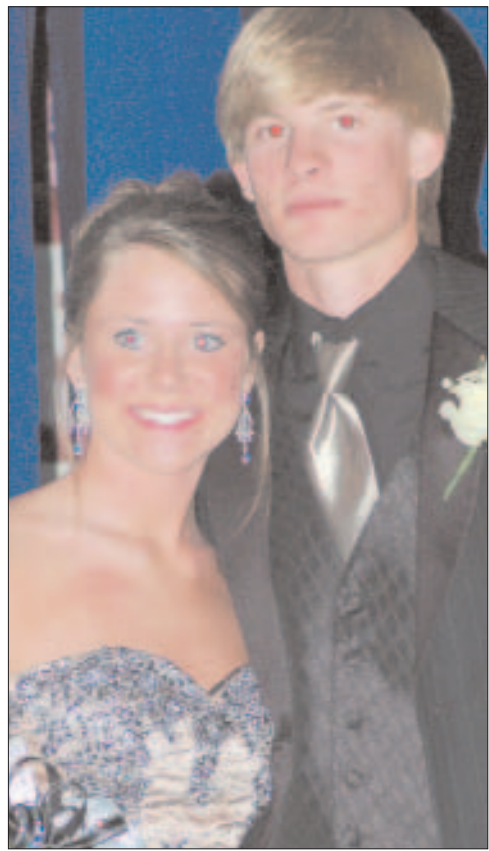
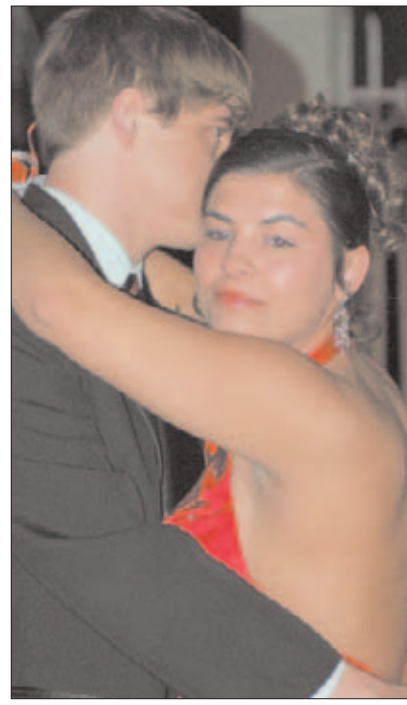


# It's PROM TIME at SCA

## CCHS chosen as site for state's Instructional Review program

BUTLER -- The Alabama State Department of Education piloted a program this year intended to assess academic performance, the learning environment, and efficiency in schools with an overall outcome of improving student achievement. Choctaw County High School was recently chosen to participate in the program.

Specific elements of interest were curriculum,

instruction, school culture, and leadership. Data was collected through observations, teacher interviews, student interviews, and documentation reviews. The data revealed an extremely sound curriculum and effective instruction. School culture was characterized by the beautiful physical structure, caring and concerned teachers, positive relationships among stu-

dents and faculty members, and safe environment.

This was directly related to the strong leadership at the school. Administrators, faculty, staff, and students at Choctaw County High School is to be commended for their ratings on the Instructional Review which is based on the Alabama Essential Elements of School Performance.
