

# Pitcher Perfect

■ Patrician's starting pitchers return to form with no-hitter against Sparta and two-hitter versus Wilcox

BUTLER — Last week, starting pitchers Kylie Lewis and Shayna Jimerson both picked up their second loss of the season, getting knocked around for 11 hits and eight earned runs in back-to-back losses to Jackson and Marengo. The dueling defeats ended a run in which the super-duo pitched four no-hitters and two one-hitters during a Saints' six-game winning streak.

In wins on Tuesday and Thursday at home against Sparta and Wilcox, the pitching pair returned to form with another no-hitter and one-hitter to add to their ever impressive stats.

Kylie Lewis (5-2) picked up the no-hitter with an absolutely amazing performance in the Saints 10-0 whipping of Sparta. Lewis struck out the first 12 batters she faced en route to a 14 strikeout performance to earn her second *no-no* of the year.

Lewis also picked up a single in two at-bats and

scored two runs with one RBI. Shayna Jimerson had two hits in three at-bats and scored two runs with one RBI. Tori Walters and Doodle Caudle picked up singles for Patrician.

Shayna Jimerson (8-2) got back on track in the Saints 11-1 win over Wilcox on Friday. Jimerson, who had been hit pretty hard in her last outing, a 10-5 loss to Jackson in which the junior surrendered eight hits and six runs in four innings, pitched a one-hitter, allowing just two hits while striking out 11 batters. The no-hitter was Jimerson's second of the season.

Amber Dobbins was the leader at the plate for the Saints with three hits in four at-bats for two RBI and three runs. All three of Dobbins' hits were doubles. Tori Walters, Allie Roach, Doodle Caudle and Brittany Lewis each collected two hits.

PA (13-4) will travel to Mobile to play in the Faith Academy Softball Tournament on Friday. Their opening game is against Clarke Prep at 9:30 a.m.
