tial Classroom, the University of Alabama Leadership Conference, and Alabama Girl's State Conference.

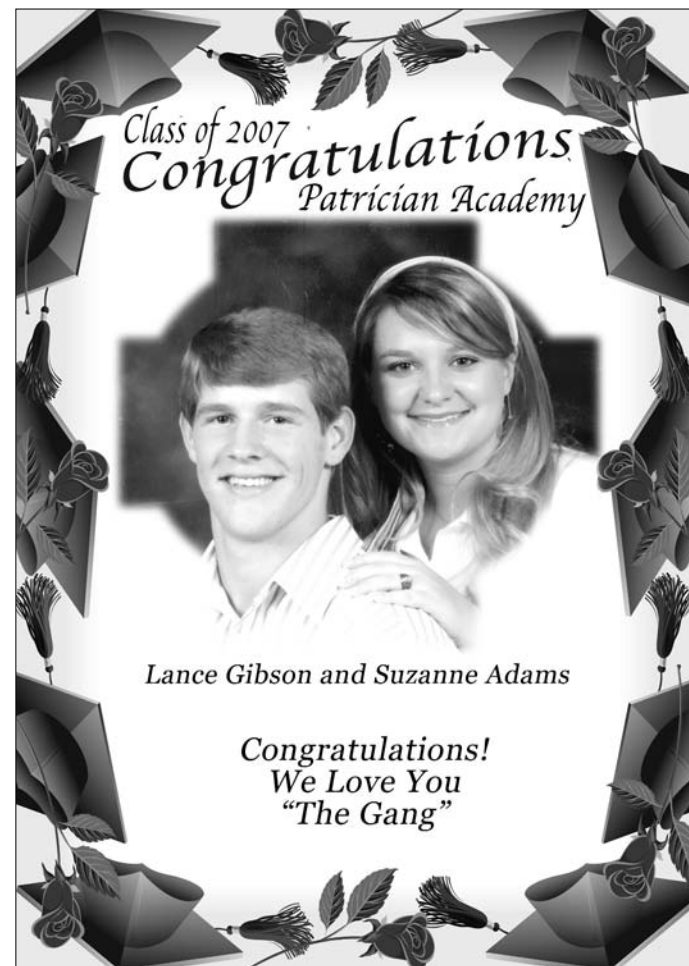
She was voted 2006 Homecoming Queen and Miss Patrician Academy, as well as Class Favorite of her senior class.
