CHS commencement exercises on May 21

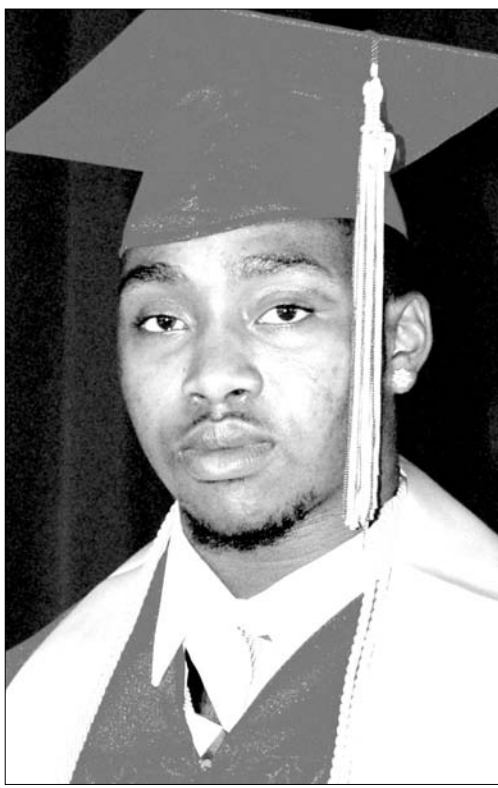

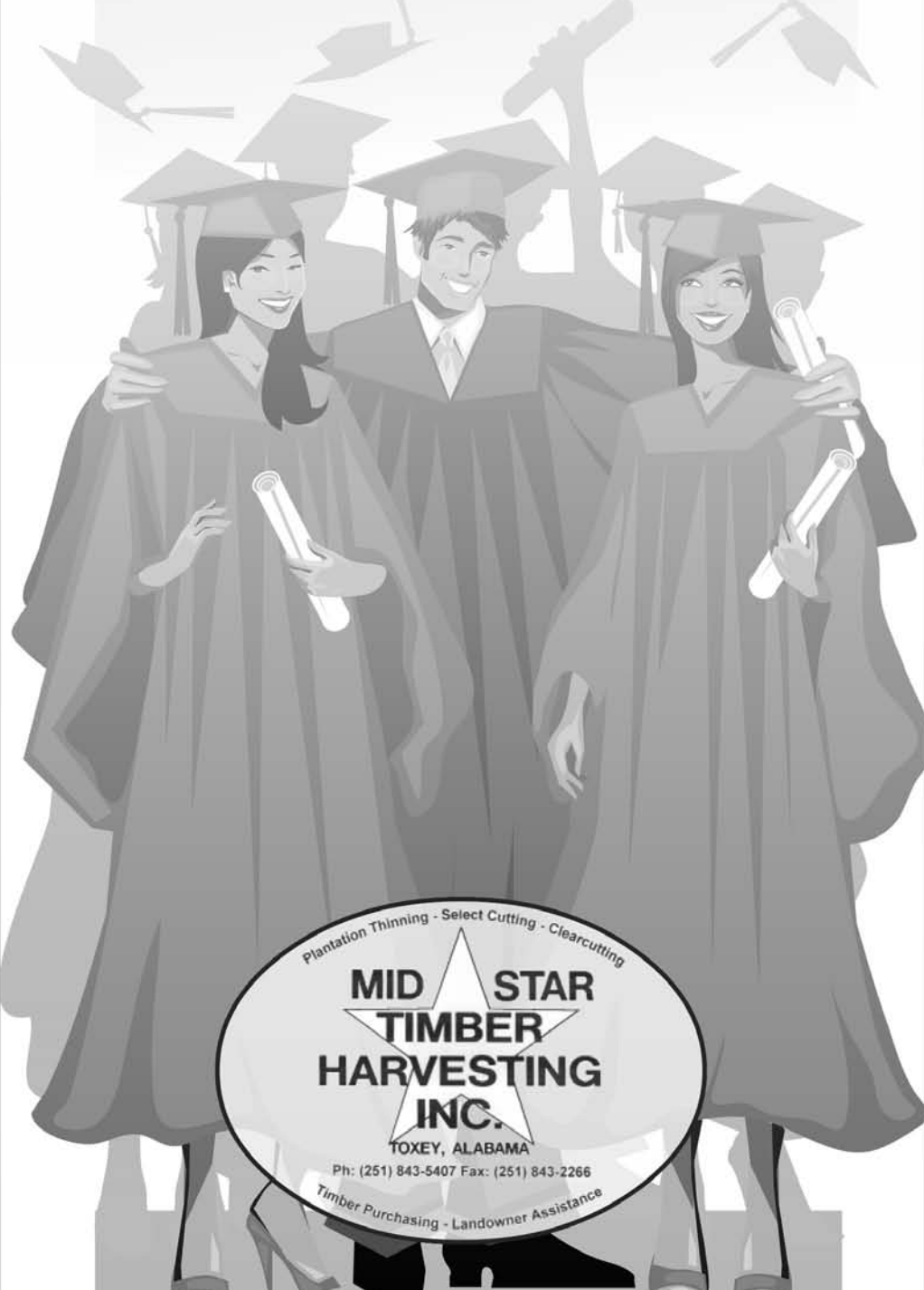
