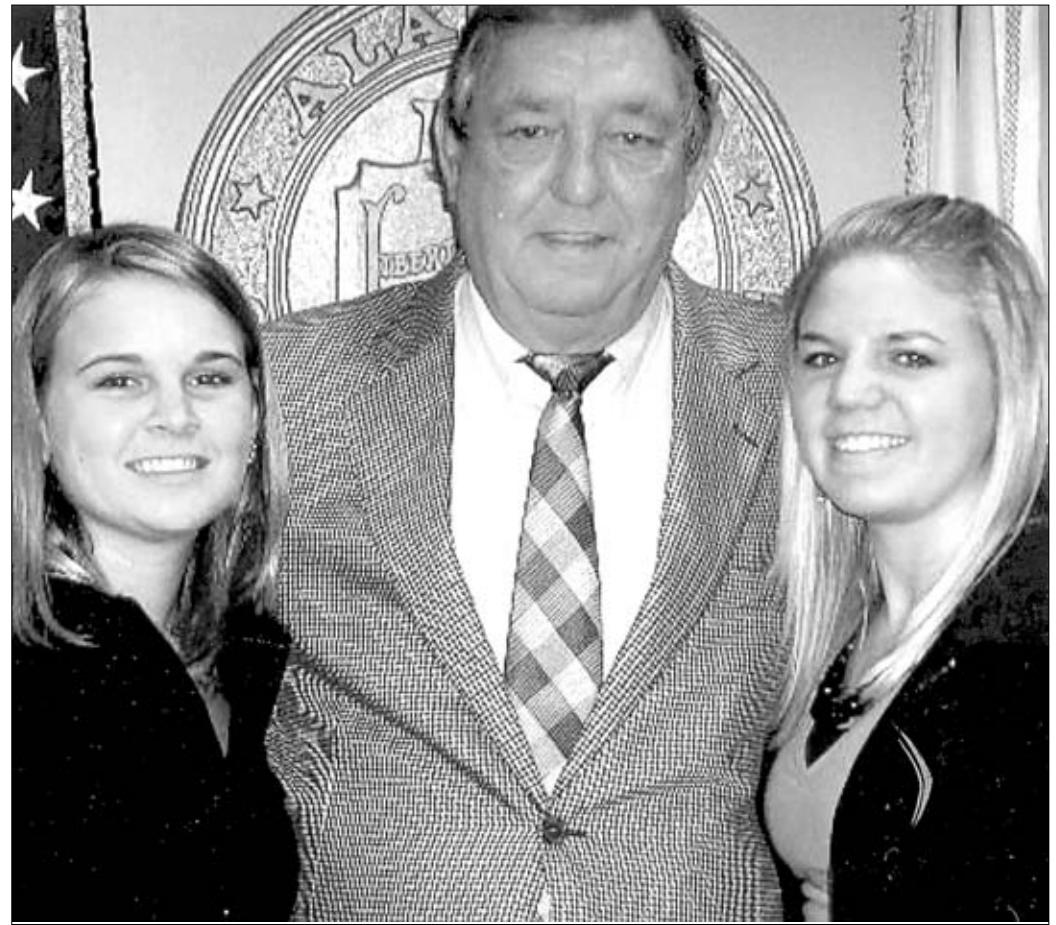

SCHS Beta Club helps send MS patients to summer camp

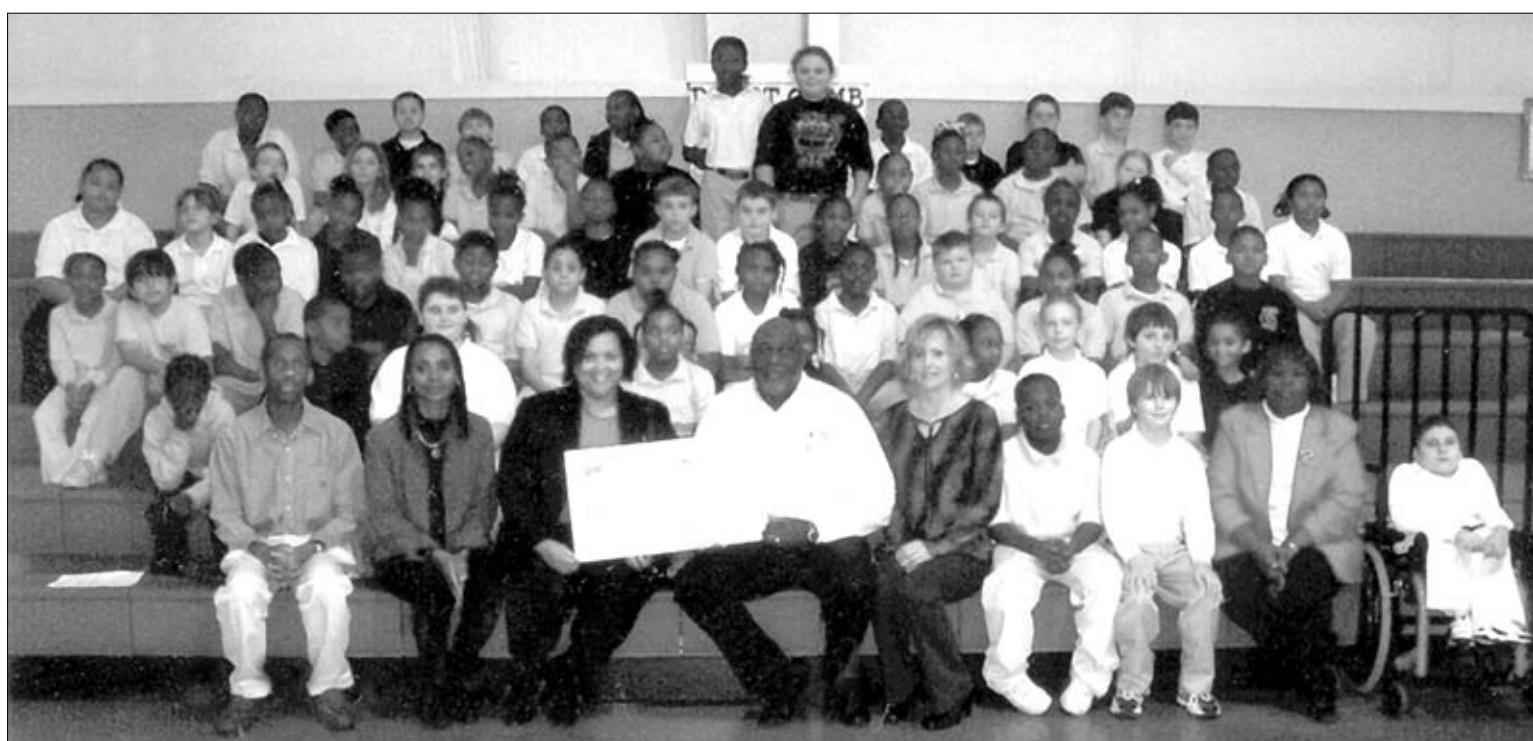
